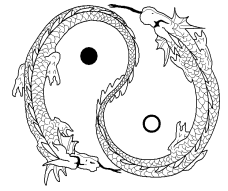

- Twin Dragon will provide Half Day and Full Day students with snacks around 10:30am and 2:30pm.
- Students are required to bring their own lunch.
- Students are not required to wear uniforms; however, we recommend they wear comfortable exercise clothes.
- Students drop off is 8:30 am to 9:00am. Half Day pick up is promptly at 12pm and Full Day pick up is promptly at 3pm. (Pick up after 3:00 may result in extra fee --\$1.00 per min. per child)
- After Care available from 3:00-4:00 for \$10.00 additional charge per day or \$35 for the week
- First Sibling receives a \$5.00 discount on full week/same week sign up.
